## Application Guidelines

Applications are available online beginning January 1, 2021. All submitted applications **must be** a copy of the completed on-line form. **Application must be received by March 19, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. at the Lodi Memorial Foundation office** at 845 S. Fairmont, Suite 3 Lodi, CA 95240 **with all requested letters and certified transcripts. Handwritten, late or incomplete applications/transcripts will not be considered.** If you fulfill the requirements for both scholarships outlined below, you will fill out only one application and then indicate it is for both the LMHF Scholarship and the Boehmer Scholarship on the application form.

- Finalists will be notified on April 16, 2021. Zoom interviewed April 22, 2021 between 1:00 - 7:30 p.m.
- Scholarship checks presented and photos taken at the Lodi Memorial Hospital Foundation Board meeting on Tuesday, May 18, 2021 @7:15 a.m. in the Lodi Memorial Hospital Board Room.
- Lodi News-Sentinel Scholarship Winner Announcement will be on Saturday, May 15, 2021.

**Lodi Memorial Hospital Foundation Scholarship Awards** are for the benefit of graduating seniors or those who have graduated from high school (**All criteria must be met**):

1. Who reside in the AH Lodi Memorial Hospital service area- including Lodi (95240, 95242), Galt (95632), Thornton (95686), Acampo (95220), Woodbridge (95258), Lockeford (95237), Clements (95227), Isleton (95641), Walnut Grove (95690), Rio Vista (94517), Herald (95638), Ione (95640), Jackson (95642), Linden (95236), Valley Springs (95252) and North Stockton (95205, 95206, 95209, 95210, 95212, 95215,95219) or currently employed at Adventist Health Lodi Memorial, eligible after a minimum one-year employment.
2. Who hold a minimum grade point average of **3.0**.

Note: 50 % of the scholarships awarded will be to students seeking education in a medical or healthcare field and the other 50 % will be awarded to other students based on need and/or academic achievement. Lodi Memorial Hospital Foundation Scholarships include the:

- Dorothy Platt Scholarship in Education
- Esther Cox Scholarship is awarded in the healthcare field

Number and size of scholarship awards are at the full discretion of the LMHF Scholarship Committee.

**The Arthur C. Boehmer and Florence Schubert Boehmer Scholarship Awards** are for the benefit of graduating seniors or those who have graduated from high school who are (**All criteria must be met**):

1. Graduates of high schools in the Lodi Unified School District area, including Lodi High School, Tokay High School, Bear Creek High School, Ronald McNair High School, Middle College High School, Plaza Robles High School, Jim Elliott Christian High School, Lodi Academy Christian High School, Aspire Benjamin Holt College Preparatory Academy, Rio Valley Charter School, Liberty High School, Independence High School, Heritage Peak Charter and Lodi One.
2. Attending a California college or university.
