Application Guidelines

Please make sure you read the Application Guidelines at least twice to ensure that you properly prepare and assemble the documents you need for a complete Scholarship Application Packet.

Application Packets will be accepted from January 1 to March 1, 2024.

Here is what that packet will consist of:

- 1. A copy of your completed, typed Online Scholarship Application.
- 2. Your School(s) <u>Sealed & Certified Transcripts.</u> If you are in your first year of college and this is your first time applying, you should include your high school transcripts.

 Transcripts may be transmitted directly from your school to <u>choff@Imhfoundation.org</u>. You must alert Carolyn Hoff that they will be coming via email.
- 3. <u>Two Current, Dated Letters of Recommendation</u> <u>Written within six months</u>. Examples being teachers, coaches, managers/supervisors and counselors.

Place these three items in the above order, paperclipped together – No Staples. Packets must be received by March 1, 2024, at the Lodi Memorial Foundation office at 845 S. Fairmont St., Suite 3, Lodi, CA 95240. Handwritten, late, or incomplete packets will not be considered.

ALL COMMUNICATIONS with you will be via email from choff@lmhfoundation.org.

Everyone- please check your junk files after 5:00pm on Friday, April 12th for your status—to see if you have been selected to be interviewed. A response is required. You will not be contacted by phone. You will be contacted by email only. Please check your email again after 5:00pm on Friday, April 19th to see if you have been awarded a scholarship. Another response is required.

- Scholarship Winners Announced Friday April 19th after 5:00pm via email.

 Board meeting on Tuesday, May 21st at 7:15 a.m. in the Lodi Memorial Hospital Board Room.
- Scholarship Winner Announcement will be in the Lodi News-Sentinel on Saturday, May 25th.

Application Guidelines 2024 cont'd

<u>Lodi Memorial Hospital Foundation Scholarship Awards</u> are for the benefit of graduating seniors or those who have graduated from high school: (All criteria must be met)

- 1. Who reside in the AH Lodi Memorial Hospital service area- including Lodi (95240, 95242), Galt (95632), Thornton, Acampo (95220), Woodbridge (95258), Lockeford (95237), Clements (95227), Isleton (95641), Walnut Grove (95690), Rio Vista (94517), Herald (95638), Ione (95640), Jackson (95642), Linden (95236), Valley Springs (95252) and North Stockton (95205, 95206, 95209, 95210, 95212, 95215, 95219).
- 2. Or are currently employed at Adventist Health Lodi Memorial, eligible after a minimum oneyear employment.
- 3. Who hold a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.2.

Note: A minimum of 50 % of these scholarships awarded will be to students seeking education in a medical or healthcare field with the balance awarded to other students based on need and/or academic achievement.

Graduates of high schools in the Lodi Unified School District, including Lodi High, Tokay High, Bear Creek High, Ronald McNair High, Middle College High, Plaza Robles High, Lincoln Technical Academy, Lodi Adult School, Liberty High, Independence School, Lodi Unified Digital Academy, Valley Robotics Academy and Turner Academy.
- 2. Attending a California college or university.
