Application Guidelines

2025

Please make sure you **read thoroughly** all Application Guidelines to ensure that you properly prepare and assemble the documents you need for a complete Scholarship Application Packet.

Application Packets will be accepted from January 1 to March 2, 2025.

Here is what that packet will consist of:

1. A copy of your completed, filled in [Online Scholarship Application](#).
2. Your School(s) [Sealed & Certified Transcripts](#). If you are in your first year of college and this is your first time applying, you should include your high school transcripts.
Transcripts may be transmitted directly from your school to choff@lmhfoundation.org. You must notify Carolyn Hoff that they will be coming via email. She will confirm receipt.
3. [Two Current, Dated Letters of Recommendation](#) – Written within six months. Examples being teachers, coaches, managers/supervisors, and counselors.

Place these three items in the above order, **paperclipped** together – **No Staples**. Packets must be received by March 2, 2025, at the Lodi Memorial Foundation office at 845 S. Fairmont St., Suite 3, Lodi, CA 95240. Handwritten, late, or incomplete packets **will not be considered**.

ALL COMMUNICATIONS with you will be via email from Carolyn Hoff at choff@lmhfoundation.org.

Add this email to your contacts for all communications will come from it.

Everyone please **double-check your spam files after 7pm on Friday, April 4th** for your status to see if you have been selected to be interviewed. A response is required. **You will not be contacted by phone. Contact will be by email only.** If you are a Finalist, please check your email again **after 5:00pm on Friday, April 11th** to see if you have been awarded a scholarship. Another response is required.

Important Dates to keep in mind:

- Finalists Emailed **Friday, April 4th after 7:00pm**– Notified of Zoom interview time on **April 10th, which will be between 1:00 - 6:00pm**
- Scholarship Winners Announced – **Friday April 11th after 5:00pm via email.**
- Scholarship checks presented and photos taken at the Lodi Memorial Hospital Foundation Board meeting on **Tuesday, May 20st at 7:15 a.m.** at AH Lodi Memorial Hospital.
- Scholarship Winner’s picture will be in the Lodi News-Sentinel on **Tuesday, May 27th.**

Application Guidelines 2025 cont'd

All Lodi Memorial Hospital Foundation Scholarship Awards are for the benefit of graduating seniors or those who have graduated from high school: (All criteria must be met)

1. Who reside in the AH Lodi Memorial Hospital service area- including Lodi (95240, 95242), Galt (95632), Thornton, Acampo (95220), Woodbridge (95258), Lockeford (95237), Clements (95227), Isleton (95641), Walnut Grove (95690), Rio Vista (94517), Herald (95638), Jackson (95642), Linden (95236), Valley Springs (95252) and North Stockton (95205, 95206, 95209, 95210, 95212, 95215, 95219).
2. Or are currently employed at Adventist Health Lodi Memorial, eligible after a minimum one-year employment.
3. Who hold a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.2.

Note: A minimum of 50 % of these scholarships awarded will be to students seeking education in a medical or healthcare field with the balance awarded to other students based on need and/or academic achievement.

The Arthur C. Boehmer and Florence Schubert Boehmer Scholarship Awards are for the benefit of graduating seniors or those who have graduated from high school who are: (All criteria must be met)

1. Graduates of high schools within the Lodi Unified School District, including Lodi High School, Tokay High School, Bear Creek High School, Ronald McNair High School, Middle College High School, Plaza Robles High School, Lincoln Technical Academy, Lodi Adult School, Liberty High School, Independence School, Lodi Unified Digital Academy, Valley Robotics Academy, Lodi Academy, Aspire Ben Holt College Preparatory Academy and Jim Elliot Christian High School.
2. Attending a California college or university.
